The world market roughly amounts to 205 M€ with a growth rate of 20%, expected to reach 900 M€ in 2015; the biomedical (biomaterials) market accounts for 22% of this data.

Discussion between companies, scientists, clinicians and patients associations shall give you the opportunity to discover and to understand the needs from patients and to get in the heart of this market.
