

# Scarf One

This scarf is 18cm wide by 3 meters long, if you want to make shorter, reduce the number of balls to 4 for about 2m long, and 5 for a work of about 2.5m.

Gauge: 13stitches/20 rows.

Material : 6 balls of Nunki Anny Blatt. Needles 6mm, cable needle.

Points and abbreviations :

*k* : knit

*p* : purl

*sl* : selvedge stitch : when it starts the row (whatever it is, right side or wrong side row) slip the stitch of the left needle to the right without knitting it. When it finishes the row, knit it. Here there are two selvedge stitches, so slip the first two stitches without knitting and knit the others as indicated, and for the last two, knit them .

Cable : on 8 stitches, slip 4 sts on the cable needle placed in front of the work, knit the next 4 sts, pick up the 4 stitches of the cable needle and knit them.

Garter stitch: knit all stitches of every rows.

Work :

Cast on 34 stitches, knit 10 rows of garter stitch and repeat this motive:

Rows 1, 3, 7 and 11 : 2sl, k8, p3, k8, p3, k8, 2sl.

Row 2 and all the wrong side rows : 2sl, p8, k3, p8, k3, p8, 2sl.

Row 5: 2sl, k8, p3, Cable, p3, k8, 2sl.

Row 9: 2sl, Cable, p3, k8, p3, Cable, 2sl.

Arriving shortly before the end of your last ball, make 10 rows of garter stitch and cast off.

Block this scarf, take in the threads and cut them short.
