# My grey pull Size S

Needles 3,5cm 12 balls (wool Bergère de France Barisienne)




# Back piece

Cast on 144 stitches & knit in stocking stitch up to 44 cm, hem included. When the piece measures 44 cm, knit all rows of rib k1p1 (knit one, purl one). When the piece measures 46 cm, bind off for <u>armholes</u> each side on every other row:

- 5 sts x1 lime,
- 1 double decrease (3 sts knitted together) x 4 times,
- 1 simple decrease (2 sts knitted together) x 1 time.

There are 116 stitches left. So on knitting all rows of k1p1.

18 cm after armholes, bind off for <u>shoulders</u> each side on every other row 8 sts x 4 times. **At** the same time, bind off for <u>neckline</u> the 28 central sts then go on knitting each side  $\mathcal{E}$  bind off 6 sts x 2 times on neckline side.



### Front piece

Knit the front piece as the back one until the armholes (included).

10 cm after the armholes, bind off for  $\frac{neckline}{neckline}$  the 36 central sts then go on knitting each side  $\epsilon$  bind off 4 sts x 2 times on neckline side.

18 cm after the armholes, bind off for shoulders each side on every other row 8 sts x 4 times.

#### Sleeves

Cast on 58 stitches & knit in stocking stitch

When the piece measures 2,5 cm, distribute increase as described below :

1- increase of 8 stitches on the  $1^{st}$  row: 8 sts, 1 increase, \* 6 sts, 1 increase\* - repeat 6 times \* \*, 8 sts.

Knit 3 rows with the 66 sts.

2- increase 8 sts on the  $5^{th}$  row: 9 sts, 1 increase, \* 7 sts, 1 increase\* - repeat 6 times\* \*, 8 sts.

Knit 3 rows with the 74 sts.

3- increase 8 sts on the  $9^{th}$  row: 9 sts, 1 increase, \*8 sts, 1 increase\* - repeat 6 times \* \*, 9 sts.


Knit 3 rows with the 82 sts.

4- increase 8 sts on the  $13^{th}$  row: 10 sts, 1 increase, \*9 sts, 1 increase\* - repeat 6 times \* \*, 9 sts.

Knit the 90 sts up to 20 cm de haut then to create the balloon effect, decrease twice distributing the decreases as described below:

- 1- knit 10 sts, 2 sts together, \* 8 sts, 2 sts together\* repeat 6 times \* \*, 8 sts. Knit 3 rows with the 82 sts.
- 2- knit 9 sts, 2 sts together, \*7 sts, 2 sts together\* repeat 6 times \* \*, 8 sts.

When the piece measures 53 cm, bind off all the stitches. Knit the second sleeve following the same explanations.



# <u>Assembly</u>

Sew the back & front pieces . Sew the sleeves to the already assembled pieces. Then close the sides.

For front & back pieces, sew a hem of 1cm.

For sleeves, sew a hem of 1 cm and before closing it, slide an 0.5 cm large elastic in order to create the balloon effect.

Once the assembly finished, pick up approx. 160 stitches for the collar with 3 3,5 cm needles (60 sts on the back piece & twice 50 sts on the front side). Knit 4 rows of rib p1k1 then bind off all stitches.

That's the end!
