

# Bonnet Introspection

Adult size, 57 to 60 cm of hat size

## Material :

1 ball of [Zauberwolle Schoppel Wolle](#).

Circular needles 3.5mm and 4mm, 1 cable needle, a sew needle

4 stitch markers (among which 1 of the colour different from 3 others to mark the beginning of the round)

## Points and abbreviations :

St : stitch

k : knit

K2tog : knit 2 together

K3tog : knit 3 together

p: purl

P2tog : purl 2 together

m1 : make one stitch

\*...\* repeat from \*to\*

(...) x... : Repeat the motive in brackets as often as it is indicated.

**Round in red:** twists in the round

**Round in green:** decreases in the round

## Double seed stitch:

Rounds 1 and 2: \*k2, p2\*

Round 3 and 4: \*p2, k2\* Repeat these 4 rounds.

## Ribs 2/2 :

Knit: \*k2, p2\*, repeat this motive during the totality of the tour, and repeat the tour as much as is needful.

## Twists:

T1: (over 4 st) slip 2 st to cable needle and hold to front, k2, k2 from cable needle

T2: (over 4 st) slip 2 st to cable needle and hold to back, k2, k2 from cable needle

T3: (over 6 st) slip 3 st to cable needle and hold to front, k3, k3 from cable needle

T4: (over 6 st) slip 3 st to cable needle and hold to back, k3, k3 from cable needle

T5: (over 6 st) slip 4 st to cable needle and hold to front, k2, k4 from cable needle

T6: (over 6 st) slip 2 st to cable needle and hold to back, k4, k2 from cable needle

T7: (over 8 st) slip 4 st to cable needle and hold to front, k4, k4 from cable needle

T8 : (over 5 st) slip 3 st to cable needle and hold to front, k2, k3 from cable needle

T9 : (over 5 st) slip 2 st to cable needle and hold to back, k3, k2 from cable needle

T 10 : (over 2 st) slip 1 st to cable needle and hold to front, k1, k1 from cable needle

T 11 : (over 2 st) slip 1 st to cable needle and hold to back, k1, k1 from cable needle

Gauge (10cm/10cm) : 20 st/32 rounds(double seed stitch needles 4mm)



## Work :

Cast on 112 st with needles 3.5mm, put the marker of stitch to indicate the beginning of the round, form the circle and make 8 rounds of ribs 2/2. Then knit with needles 4mm and do a round of increases:

(k2, m1) x48, k16, (160st)

**Round 1 :** \*(k2,p2) x3, T1, k4, T2, k2, p2, T1, k2, p2, T2\*

*Note: you can put a marker after every motive bounded by \* \**

Round 2 : \*(k2,p2) x3, k14, p2, k6, p2, k4\*

Round 3 and 4 : \*(p2, k2) x3, 1k2, p2, k6, p2, k6\*

**Round 5 :** \*(k2, p2) x3,T3, T4, k2, p2, T1, k2,p2, T2\*

Round 6 : \*(k2, p2) x3,k14, p2, k6, p2, k4\*

Round 7 and 8 : \*(p2, k2) x3, x3, k12, p2, k6, p2, k6\*

**Round 9 :** \*(k2, p2) x3,T3, T4, k2, p2, T1, k2,p2, T2\*

Round 10 : \*(k2, p2) x3,k14, p2, k6, p2, k4\*

Round11 and 12 : \*(p2, k2) x3, k12, p2, k6, p2, k6\*

**Round 13 and 17 :** \*(k2, p2) x3,T4, T3, k2, p2, T1, k2, p2, T2\*

Round 14 and 18: \*(k2, p2) x3,k14, p2, k6, p2, k4\*

Round15, 16,19 and 20 : \*(p2, k2) x3, k12, p2, k6, p2, k6\*

**Round 21 :** \*(k2, p2) x3,T2, k4, T1, k2, p2, T1, k2, p2, T2\*

Round 22 : \*(k2, p2) x3,k14, p2, k6, p2, k4\*

**Round 23 :** \*(p2, k2) x3, k12, p2, k2 T5, T6\*

Round 24 : \*(p2, k2) x3, k12, p2, k2, p2, k10\*

**Round 25 :** \*(k2, p2) x3,T1, k4, T2, k2, p2, k2, T7, p2 \*

Round 26 : \*(k2, p2) x3, k14, p2,k10, p2 \*

Round 27 and 28 : \*(p2, k2) x3, k12, p2, k2, p2, k10\*

**Round 29, 33 and 37:** \*(k2, p2) x3,T3, T4, k2, p2, k2, T7, p2 \*

Round 30, 34 and 38 : \*(k2, p2) x3,k14, p2, k10, p2, \*

Round 31 and 32, 35 and 36 : \*(p2, k2) x3,k12, p2, 2md, p2, 10md\*

**Round 39 :** \*(p2, k2) x3, K2tog, k8, K2tog, (p2, k2) x2, K2togx2, k4\*

Round 40 : \*(p2, k2) x3, 1k0, (p2, k2) x2, k6\*

**Round 41 :** \*(k2, p2) x3,T8, T9, k2, p2, k2, T3, p2\*

Round 42 : \*(k2, p2) x3,k12, p2, k6, p2\*

**Round 43 :** \*(p2, k2) x3, K2tog, k6, K2tog, p2, k2, p2, k1, K2togx2, k3\*

Round 44 : \*(p2, k2) x3, k8, p2, k2, p2, k6\*

**Round 45 :** \*(k2, p2) x3, T1, T2, k2, p2, k2, T1, p2.\*

Round 46 : \*(k2, p2) x3,k10, p2, k6, p2\*

**Round 47 :** \*(p2, k2) x2, p2, K2tog, k8, P2tog, K2tog, P2tog, k6\*

Round 48 : \*(p2, k2) x2, p2, k9, p1, k1, p1, k6\*

**Round 49 :** \*(k2, p2) x2, k2, p1, T1, T2, k1, p1, k1, T1, p2.\*

Round 50 : \*(k2, p2) x2, k2, p1, k9, p1, k5, p2\*

**Round 51 :** \*(P2tog, K2tog) x2, P2tog, k9, p1, k1, p1, k4, K2tog\*

Round 52 : \*(p1, k1) x3, k8, p1, k1, p1, k5\*

**Round 53 :** \*(k1, p1) x3,T1, T2, k1, p1, k1, T1, p1\*

Round 54 : \*(k1, p1) x3, k9, p1, k5, p1\*

**Round 55 :** \*(p1, k1) x3, , K2togx4, p1, k1, p1, K2togx2\*

Round 56 : \*(p1, k1) x3, k4, p1, k1, p1, k2.\*

**Round 57 :** \*(k1, p1) x3,T10, T11, k1, p1, k1, T10, p10\*

Round 58 : \*(k1, p1) x3, k5, p1, k3, p1\*

Round 59 and 60 : \*p1, k1\*

**Round 61 :** \*K3tog, p1, k1, p1\*, finish with : p1, k1, p1.

Round 62 : \*k1, p1\*

Cut the thread from 30 cms long, pass the wool needle in all the stitches and fix the top of the hat. Bring in the threads and cut them to short.
