

Bibracte Shawl

This shawl is inspired by the beautiful beech forest located on the slopes of Mont Beuvray on the Gallo-Roman site of Bibracte (Burgundy, France). These trees unusual twisted trunks and humidity prevailing in these places that many of them are covered with moss bright green, chlorophyll real bath!

Its basic shape is triangular with a perforated center line (may be replaced by a solid line according to your preference), it is enlarged with rows containing many rises, which softened the form global shawl. The twisted edge, laced, finished by picots, is then added, perpendicular to the body of the shawl and connected row by row during the knitting stage, excluding the seams.



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Size of the work done: 190cm/80cm

Material :

6 skeins of [Silk Blend Fino Manos del Uruguay](#).

Circular needles 4mm and a cable of 120mm minimum, stitch markers.

needles 4mm(one is enough to knit the edge)

cable needle, row counter, sew needle.

Points and abbreviations :

k : knit

k : central knit stitch of the body of the shawl

p : purl

sl : slip stitch

st : stitch

M : stitch marker

Yo : Yarn over.

m1r : make one stitch right

m1l : make one stitch left

K2tog : knit 2 stitches together

K2tog : knit an edge stitch and a stitch of the body of the shawl together. (This stitch makes the connection between the edge and the body of the shawl)

SKP : slip one st, knit 1, pass the slip stitch over the knit stitch.

S2KP : slip 2 st, knit 1, pass the 2 slip stitches over the knit stitch.

SSK: slip, slip, knit: slip next 2 st knitwise, insert tip of left needle into front of these 2 st and knit them together.

DC4 : central decrease of 4 stitches : slip 3 stitches from the left to the right needle(prick the stitch in front), knit together the 2 following stitches, pass over one by one the 3 slip stitches.

K3togtbl : knit 3 stitches together through back loop.

Picot : knit 1 stitch, put this knit stitch back on the left needle.. Prick the right needle between the stitch that has been knitted and the one that follows. Make a loop around the right needle, take out the loop with the right needle and place it on the left needle as a result of the knitted stitch: stitch is created. Repeat this process 3 more times, creating a total of 4 st, bindoff 4 stitches after being knitted and continue the row as indicated.

(...) X ...: Knit the pattern in brackets as many times as is indicated after "x".

Gauge (stocking stitch, 10cm/10cm) : 24 st/33 rows.:

Twists:

T1 on 4 st. : slip 2 st. to cable needle and hold to back, k2, k2 from cable needle .

T2 on 4 st. : slip 2 st. to cable needle and hold to front, k2, k2 from cable needle .

T3 on 8 st, : slip 5 st. to cable needle and hold to back, k3, p2 and then k3 from the cable needle.

T4 on 8 st, :, slip 3 st. to cable needle and hold to front, k3, p2, and then k3 from the cable needle.

Work :

Body of the shawl :

Cast on 3 stitches. Knit 6 rows (but not turn the work after the last row). Make a rotation of the work of 90 ° and knit 3 stitches along the side of your strip of knitting, one in each garter ridge (we obtain 6 stitches). Make again a rotation of 90 ° of your work clockwise, knit 3 stitches in the row of assembly. We obtain 9 stitches.

Row 1(right side row): k3, Yo, k1, Yo, M, **k1**, M,Yo, k1, Yo, k3.

Row 2 (wrong side row): k3, purl all stitches following to last 3 stitches that will be knit.

Row 3 : k3, Yo, k3, Yo, M, **k1**, M, Yo, k3, Yo, k3.

Row 4: k3, purl all stitches following to last 3 stitches that will be knit.

Row 5: k3, Yo, knit all the following sts until the first stitch marker, Yo before the stitch marker, M, **k1**, M, Yo, knit all the following stitches until the 3 last stitches, Yo, k3.

Row 6: k3, purl all stitches following to last 3 stitches that will be knit.

Repeat rows 5 and 6 up to row 132 included, except the following rows, where you have to follow the instructions specified below:

Row 41: k3, Yo, k1, (k4, m1r)x10, Yo, M, **k1**, M, Yo, (m1l, k4)x10, k1, Yo, k3.

Row 85: k3, Yo, (k5, m1r)x19, Yo, M,**k1**, M, Yo, (m1l, k5)x19, Yo, k3.

Row 121: k3, Yo, (k10, m1r)x15, Yo, M, **k1**, M , Yo, (m1l, k10)x15, Yo, k3.

Row 131: k3, Yo, k1, m1r, k174, Yo, M, **knit 2 stitches in the central stitch** (once a front loop, once a back loop), M, Yo, k174, m1l, k1, Yo, k3.

Edge :

To facilitate reading of the pattern, I colored the parts, which can be physically demarcated by a stitch marker on the work (if you wish): **Green**: twists **Blue**: twisted leaves.

The edge is worked perpendicular to the body of the shawl. Cast on 63 st.

Do 1 row : sl1, k61, **K2tog**. The next wrong side row: k63

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Edge: first part.

Repeat 15 times following 24 rows (for a total of 360 rows to reach the center of the body of the shawl):

Row 1 (right side row) : 1 picot, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, **(k3, p2)x3 k3**, p2, **T1**, Yo, k1, Yo, **T2**, p2, **(k3, p2)x3 k3**, p1, k2, Yo, SSK, k1, **K2tog**. (65st).

Row 2 (wrong side row) : p2, Yo, SSK, p2, k1, **(p3, k2) x3, p3**, k2, **p11**, k2, **(p3, k2) x3, p3**, k1, p2, Yo, SSK, p2. (65st)

Row 3 (right side row) : sl1, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, **(k3, p2)x3 k3**, p2, **T1**, **(k1, Yo)x2, k1, T2**, p2, **(k3, p2)x3 k3**, p1, k2, Yo, SSK, k1, **K2tog**. (67st).

Rows 4 and 22 (wrong side row) : p2, Yo, SSK, p2, k1, **(p3, k2) x3, p3**, k2, **p13**, k2, **(p3, k2) x3, p3**, k1, p2, Yo, SSK, p2. (67st)

Row 5 : 1 picot, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, **k3, p2, T3, p2, k3**, p2, **T1, k2, Yo, k1, Yo, k2, T2**, p2, **k3, p2, T4, p2, k3**, p1, k2, Yo, SSK, k1, **K2tog**. (69st).

Rows 6 and 20: p2, Yo, SSK, p2, k1, **(p3, k2) x3, p3**, k2, **p15**, k2, **(p3, k2) x3, p3**, k1, p2, Yo, SSK, p2. (69st)

Row 7: sl1, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, **T3, p2, T3**, p2, **T1, k3, Yo, k1, Yo, k3 T2**, p2, **T4, p2, T4**, p1, k2, Yo, SSK, k1, **K2tog**. (71st).

Rows 8 and 18: p2, Yo, SSK, p2, k1, **p18**, k2, **p17**, k2 **p18**, k1, p2, Yo, SSK, p2. (71st)

Row 9: 1 picot, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, **k3, p2, T3, p2, k3**, p2, **T1, k4, Yo, k1, Yo, k4, T2**, p2, **k3, p2, T4, p2, k3**, p1, k2, Yo, SSK, k1, **K2tog**. (73st).

Rows 10, 12, 14 and 16: p2, Yo, SSK, p2, k1, **(p3, k2) x3, p3**, k2, **p19**, k2, **(p3, k2) x3, p3**, k1, p2, Yo, SSK, p2. (73st)

Row 11: sl1, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, **T3, p2, T3**, p2, **T1, k11, T2**, p2, **T4, p2, T4**, p1, k2, Yo, SSK, k1, **K2tog**. (73st).

Row 13: 1 picot, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, **k3, p2, T3, p2, k3**, p2, **T1, Yo, SKP, k7, SSK Yo, T2**, p2, **k3, p2, T4, p2, k3**, p1, k2, Yo, SSK, k1, **K2tog**. (73st).

Row 15: sl1, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, **k3, p2, T3, p2, k3**, p2, **T1, Yo, SKP, k7, SSK, Yo, T2**, p2, **k3, p2, T4, p2, k3**, p1, k2, Yo, SSK, k1, **K2tog**. (73st).

Row 17: 1 picot, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, **(k3, p2)x3 k3**, p2, **T1, Yo, S2KP, k5, k3Togtbl, Yo, T2**, p2, **(k3, p2)x3 k3**, p1, k2, Yo, SSK, k1, **K2tog**. (71st).

Row 19: sl1, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, **(k3, p2)x3 k3**, p2, **T1, Yo, S2KP, k3, k3Togtbl, Yo, T2**, p2, **(k3, p2)x3 k3**, p1, k2, Yo, SSK, k1, **K2tog**. (69st).

Row 21: 1 picot, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, (k3, p2)x3 k3, p2, T1, Yo, S2KP, k1, k3Togtbl, Yo, T2, p2, (k3, p2)x3 k3, p1,k2,Yo, SSK, k1,K2tog. (67st).

Row 23: sl1, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, (k3, p2)x3 k3,p2, T1,DC4, T2, p2, (k3, p2)x3 k3, p1,k2,Yo, SSK, k1,K2tog. (63st).

Row 24: p2, Yo, SSK, p2, k1, (p3, k2) x3, p3, k2, p9, k2, (p3, k2) x3, p3, k1, p2,Yo, SSK, p2. (63st)

Edge : second part.

Repeat 15 times following 24 rows :

Row 1(right side row) : 1 picot, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, (k3, p2)x3 k3, p2, T1, Yo, k1, Yo, T2, p2, (k3, p2)x3 k3, p1, k2, Yo, SSK, k1, K2tog. (65st).

Row 2 (wrong side row) : p2,Yo, SSK, p2, k1, (p3, k2) x3, p3, k2, p11, k2, (p3, k2) x3, p3, k1, p2, Yo, SSK, p2. (65st)

Row 3 (right side row) : sl1, k1, Yo, SSK,k2, p1, (k3, p2)x3 k3, p2, T1, Yo, k3, Yo, T2, p2, (k3, p2)x3 k3, p1, k2, Yo, SSK, k1, K2tog. (67st).

Rows 4 and 22 (wrong side row) : p2, Yo, SSK, p2, k1, (p3, k2) x3, p3, k2, p13, k2, (p3, k2) x3, p3, k1, p2,Yo, SSK, p2. (67st)

Row 5 : 1 picot, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, k3, p2, T3, p2, k3, p2, T1, Yo, k5, Yo, T2, p2, k3, p2, T4, p2, k3, p1, k2, Yo, SSK, k1, K2tog. (69st).

Rows 6 and 20: p2, Yo, SSK, p2, k1, (p3, k2) x3, p3, k2, p15, k2, (p3, k2) x3, p3, k1, p2,Yo, SSK, p2. (69st)

Row 7: sl1, k1,Yo, SSK,k2, p1, T3, p2, T3, p2, T1, Yo, k7, Yo, T2, p2,T4, p2, T4, p1,k2,Yo, SSK, k1,K2tog. (71st).

Rows 8 and 18: p2, Yo, SSK, p2, k1, p18, k2, p17, k2 p18, k1, p2,Yo, SSK, p2. (71st)

Row 9: 1 picot, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, k3, p2, T3, p2, k3, p2, T1, Yo, k9, Yo, T2, p2, k3, p2, T4, p2, k3, p1, k2, Yo, SSK, k1, K2tog. (73st).

Rows 10, 12, 14 and 16 p2, Yo, SSK, p2, k1, (p3, k2) x3, p3, k2, p19, k2, (p3, k2) x3, p3, k1, p2,Yo, SSK, p2. (73st)

Row 11: sl1, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, T3, p2, T3, p2, T1, k11, T2, p2, T4, p2, T4, p1,k2,Yo, SSK, k1, K2tog. (73st).

Row 13: 1 picot, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, k3, p2, T3, p2, k3, p2, T1,SKP, k3, Yo, k1, Yo, k3, K2tog, T2, p2, k3, p2, T4, p2, k3, p1,k2,Yo, SSK, k1, K2tog. (73st).

Row15: sl1, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1,k3, p2, T3, p2, k3, p2, T1,SKP, k3, Yo, k1, Yo, k3, K2tog, T2, p2, k3, p2, T4, p2, k3, p1,k2,Yo, SSK, k1, K2tog. (73st).

Row 17 :1 picot, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, (k3, p2)x3 k3, p2,T1, S2KP, k2, Yo, k1, Yo, k2, K3Togtbl, T2, p2, (k3, p2)x3 k3, p1,k2,Yo, SSK, k1,K2tog. (71st).

Row 19: sl1, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, (k3, p2)x3 k3, p2,T1, S2KP, k1, Yo, k1, Yo, k1, K3Togtbl, T2, p2, (k3, p2)x3 k3, p1,k2,Yo, SSK, k1,K2tog. (69st).

Row 21 : 1 picot, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, (k3, p2)x3 k3, p2,T1, S2KP, Yo, k1, Yo, K3Togtbl, T2, p2, (k3, p2)x3 k3, p1,k2,Yo, SSK, k1,K2tog. (67st).

Row 23 : sl1, k1, Yo, SSK, k2, p1, (k3, p2)x3 k3,p2, T1,DC4, T2, p2, (k3, p2)x3 k3, p1,k2,Yo, SSK, k1,K2tog. (63st).

Row 24 : p2, Yo, SSK, p2, k1, (p3, k2) x3, p3, k2, p9, k2, (p3, k2) x3, p3, k1, p2, Yo, SSK, p2. (63st)

Do a right side row : sl1, k61, K2tog, a wrong side row : k63, another right side row: sl1, k61, K2tog. Bind off the 63 stitches on the next wrong side row

Bring in the threads, [block the shawl](#) and cut the threads.
